Returning from abroad, the client wanted a fresh approach to living in their Cotswolds home, including a light, airy open-plan kitchen. The kitchen had to be truly functional, providing for cooking, family dining, home working and relaxing. The design centres on an appliance wall and two full-length islands: one for prep and cooking, the other a home workspace and for dining. A simple white scheme has been used with various textures adding interest. The islands are clad in Corian with the units underneath in bespoke patinated brass. Pale limestone tiles have been used for the floor; the kitchen end unit is clad to the top and sides in bleached oak boards to connect with the oak floor abutting the kitchen area. Features designed into the kitchen include laptop charging drawers, breakfast cupboard, double-entry larder, wine room, pop-up TV, bespoke slate insert, and drawers for knives, herbs and spices, and silver cutlery.
